

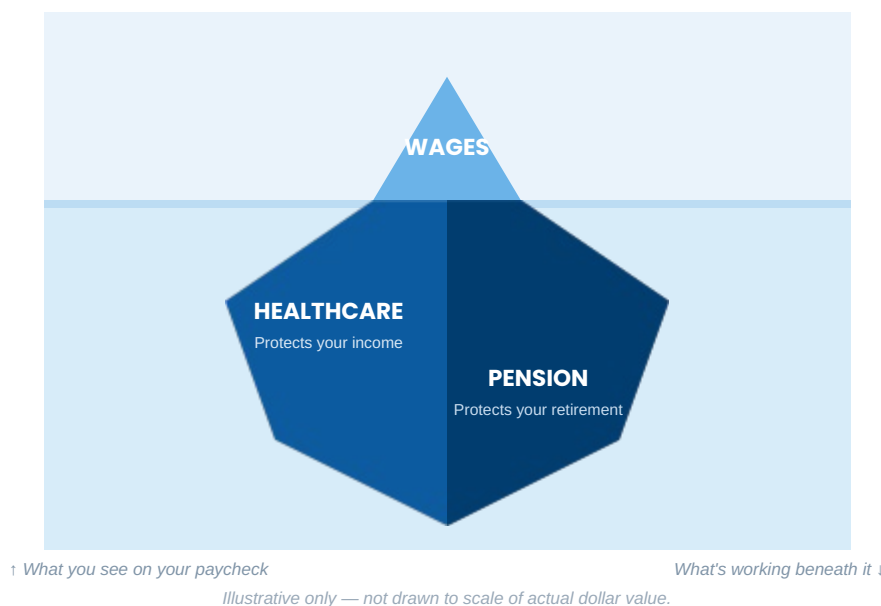
Your Total Compensation

Wages



The number on your check stub — visible, direct, and the company investment associates likely think of first.

Healthcare



A major company investment that works quietly in the background to protect your income from rising medical costs.

Pension



A long-term company-funded investment building toward your retirement, on top of your everyday pay.
